Our clubhouse bar license has just been renewed for a new term and I am very thankful to the following members that took the time to get certified by the ABC in the Responsible Beverage Server (RBS) program. A great BIG Thank you to, Ryan Jewell, Tom Cheddar, Kyle & Susan Cordes, Tommy Keller, Magic Rossi, Bill Power, and Kathy Teresi. I now have all of your certifications, along with my own, associated to the MWYC liquor license.

Some of you have asked for a training session of our bar operations and I am happy to make the time to do this in a small group or on an individual basis. None of us are expected to be master mixologists so please do not let this be a hindrance to helping your club by volunteering behind the bar. I can show you in about 20 - 30 minutes about how we set up, and close the bar. Also, where we keep the supplies and some basics for making the most common drinks our members request. Using the Square system to charge a member for drink tokens is easier than you might think. Let me know if you want to help and get some training.

A reminder that the "TIP" jar on the bar is for our Maintenance Fund. That is primarily used for cleaning supplies and the labor for the person who performs most of the after-event housekeeping chores. Please give to this fund so we may all enjoy the club more and not have to work too hard.
